Burrtec's Agua Mansa Composting	This Engineered Compost System (ECS) is a new site in the very restrictive South Coast Air Quality District. They receive 30,000 tpy of typical L.A. basin semi—source-separated organics and they have worked out a pretty ingenious yet simple method to remove contamination. More info on Burrtec and ECS
Recycled Wood Products and Kellogg Garden Products	Participants will go on a walking tour on site at Kellogg Garden Products' Ontario facility and the neighboring Recycled Wood Products (RWP) facility, in which they will learn about the journey from compost manufacturer to a consumer's backyards. Kellogg is a B2B company specializing in soil and compost products for organic gardens, and sells wholesale to large retailers such as Home Depot as Lowes, as well as smaller chains and independent nurseries. Inland Empire Regional Composting Facility	Participants will tour one of the largest indoor ASP composting operations in the country at the Inland Empire Utilities Agency. They will take turns going on driving tours of the composting facility and learning about the facility, biofiltration, and a Q&A with the Project Manager. More info on the IERCA
Burrtec's West Valley MRF and Composting Operation	This Burrtec facility features a GORE Cover™ composting system, plus floor sorting for contamination removal More info on Burrtec and Gore Cover System
